

## **Sean's Awesome Repair Kit**

Important note: Each party member must be responsible for specific requirements to repair their own bindings and crampons.

### **Tools:**

Small needle nose vice grips  
Very small adjustable wrench  
Leatherman "Wave" (with saw, file, hack saw, scissors, multiple screwdriver tips)

### **Parts:**

Ski pole basket  
15 cm reinforced garden hose (x2)  
12cm x 30cm hypalon (very heavy rubberized fabric)  
8 AA alkaline batteries  
6 AAA alkaline batteries  
60cm leather strap with buckle (x2)  
Tent pole repair sleeve (x2)  
Stove repair Kit(s)  
Assorted Fastex buckles in ¾", 1", 1 ½" and 2" sizes  
Assorted triglides in same sizes (see previous item)  
Cord locks (x4)  
Various lengths of 1" flat webbing

### **Adhesion, connection:**

Duct tape  
Hose clamps (x2 small, x2 medium, x1 large)  
Zip ties (x7 very large, x10 medium)  
Thermarest repair kit  
Freesole adhesive  
Adhesive patches  
5-minute epoxy  
Sewing Kit  
60cm 2mm accessory cord  
50cm 3mm bungy cord  
60cm 3mm accessory cord  
ski binding screws (various lengths)  
Assorted nuts, bolts, washers  
Wire  
50cm Allround (metal strapping with pre-drilled holes)

This is what we had. We also really needed skin glue which we were lucky to borrow from Dr. Bamford.
